Our impact on farmer's livelihood and beyond

Sunvado is Tradin Organic's processing facility in Ethiopia for premium organic **avocado oil** that is **fully traceable**. It is located about 300km south of Addis Ababa in a lush area rich in **natural agroforestry**.

We work with over 59,000 organic avocado farmers who provide the avocados that are pressed in our factory. Before Sunvado opened its doors in 2018, the farmers did not have access to an export market for their avocados.

Most of the harvest was sold on the local market at very low prices. Sunvado set up the **organic certification** of the farmers, and they now receive an organic **premium** on top of an increased price.



From Farm to Factory to Customer

Our integrated supply chain guarantees **full traceability, organic integrity and high-quality** pure avocado Oil from farm to factory to customer. Tradin has also invested in state-of-the art machinery that will elevate food safety standards to meet EU and US regulations. Guidelines on managing and revaluing the by-products from oil processing are being developed to increase the sustainability of the agro industrial park in Yirga Alem and Sunvado's production line.



Social and Environmental Impact

Biodiversity & local capacity

- Farmer Business Training to over 20.000 farmers on how to manage a farm as a business, calculate profit, how diversify their crops, make beneficial economic decisions about their farm, and more.
- International partnerships to provide farmers with beekeeping training and transitional modern beehives for improving their income and increasing the avocado tree yield.
- Training in simplified and relatively modern composting techniques (Vermicomposting).

Certifications

- Our avocado oil complies with international organic regulations.
- The factory undergoes regular Sedex SMETA audits.
- Our certifications and audits ensure that our organic avocado oil is produced with minimal impact for the environment, preserving biodiversity and ensuring the safety of our facilities.



Climate smart agriculture

- Sunvado's agronomists and field staff continuously train farmers on good organic agricultural practices, that also make them more resilient to climate change.
- Together with international partners, we are also planting new trees and investigating if the farmers can earn additional income from carbon sequestration.
